Current:

Standing Rule 11(c)3 - If there are 2 or more proposed candidates for special award honors each voting member may vote for only 1 of the nominees with a total of 12 votes from the 22 member board being required for election to for the special award

Change:

If there are 2 or more proposed candidates for special award honors each voting member may vote for up to 2 of the nominees or none at all. A majority of board members present must list the names on their ballot for their election. Eliminate 11(c)7 completely as it becomes duplicitous.

Reason:

1- Not all 22 board members are always present and although 11(c)7 addresses that issue 11(c)7 can be eliminated thru this comprehensive change. This does allow up to 2 hall of fame special awards if they are listed on the majority of ballots. Nothing in standing rules state only 1 special award is allowed each year although that has been the practice. This proposal requires only 1 vote whereas other proposals can lead to 2 separate votes.
