Points to be given on Open Tournaments listed in the centerfold of the preview, in accordance with the FSA Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:

Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
Red Line Statewide Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
Red Line Statewide Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation

#### Change

Points to be given on Open Tournaments listed in the centerfold of the preview, in accordance with the FSA Roll of Champions Point System based on chart size for Statewide Singles and Doubles are as follows:

128 Chart 8-6-5-3 Main; and 3-2-1-0.5 Consolation  
64 Chart 6-5-4-3 Main; and 3-2-1-0.5 Consolation  
32 Chart 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
16 Chart 4-3-2-1 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
8 Chart 3-2-1-0.5 Main; and 0.5-0-0-0 Consolation

Red Line Statewide Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation  
Red Line Statewide Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation

#### Rationale

This point chart is based on a fair and equitable point system for the number of shuffleboard players participating in any size tournament. Due to split tournaments, the size of participation can range from a 128 Chart all the way down to an 8 chart. There is no way the current universal point system can represent the FSA's commitment to all shufflers, to provide a fair and equitable awarding system of earned points.
