## STATE AND DISTRICT TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS - ART. 10 (e)

Art. 10 - TROPHIES AND PRIZES
(e) Points to be given in Open Tournaments listed in the Centerfold of the Preview, in accordance with the F.S.A. Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:

Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division. (March 2022)
Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division). (March 2022)
Red Line State Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-1 Consolation (March 2022)
(1) If there are less than 16 players, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (March 2021)
Red Line State Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more teams in the division). (March 2022)
Regardless of the foregoing provisions, no points shall be awarded to any player who fails to win at least one match during the tournament. (March 2018)

CHANGE AS FOLLOWS (in Red):
(e) Points to be given in Open Tournaments listed in the Centerfold of the Preview, in accordance with the F.S.A. Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:

Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (2-1-1-1/2 if there are 16 or more players in the Division.
Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1- $1 / 2$ if there are 16 or more players teams in the Division).

## Red Line State Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-1/2 Consolation

(1) If there are less than 16 players, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation. (March 2021)
Red Line State Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (2-1-1- $1 / 2$ if there are 16 or more teams in the division).

Regardless of the foregoing provisions, no points shall be awarded to any player who fails to win at least one match during the tournament. (March 2018)

## REASON FOR CHANGES IN RED ABOVE:

- Replacing "teams" where it says "players" is self-explanatory because it is referring to the "Doubles."
- For both the Singles and Doubles Division where there are 16 or more in said Divisions, changing to a $1 / 2$ point versus 1 point for $4^{\text {th }}$ Consolation would possibly entice the individuals to finish the match for the extra $1 / 2$ point. Currently, with awarding one (1) point each for both $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ Consolation, there is no incentive for playing/finishing the match, possibly resulting in players not returning to play.
