## STATE AND DISTRICT TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS - ART. 10 (e)

## Art. 10 - TROPHIES AND PRIZES

(e) Points to be given in Open Tournaments listed in the Centerfold of the Preview, in accordance with the F.S.A. Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:

Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division. (March 2022)
Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division). (March 2022)
Red Line State Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-1 Consolation (March 2022)
(1) If there are less than 16 players, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (March 2021)
Red Line State Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more teams in the division). (March 2022)
Regardless of the foregoing provisions, no points shall be awarded to any player who fails to win at least one match during the tournament. (March 2018)

CHANGE AS FOLLOWS (in Red):
(e) Points to be given in Open Tournaments listed in the Centerfold of the Preview, in accordance with the F.S.A. Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:

Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division.
Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 (Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the Division).
(1) If there are eight (8) Teams or less, the tournament will be played as Singles Non Walking.
Red Line State Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-1 Consolation
(1) If there are less than 16 players, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation. (March 2021)

Red Line State Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more teams in the division).
(1) If there are less than 16 teams, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation.
Regardless of the foregoing provisions, no points shall be awarded to any player who fails to win at least one match during the tournament. (March 2018)

## REASON FOR CHANGES IN RED ABOVE:

1. Currently, for the doubles tournaments that result in eight (8) teams or less, all teams will automatically get points (except for $4^{\text {th }}$ Consolation); therefore, it would be more equitable versus doubles tournaments with more than 8 teams when awarding points.
2. Adding (1) under Red Line State Doubles coincides with (1) under Red Line State Singles, eliminating higher "red line" points for less than 16 teams.
