Article 10

- (e) Points to be given in Open Tournaments listed in the Centerfold of the Preview, in accordance with the F.S.A. Roll of Champions Point System are as follows:
- Statewide Singles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more players in the division). (March 2022)
 - Statewide Doubles 5-4-3-2 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more teams in the division). (March 2022)
 - Red Line State Singles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-1 Consolation. (March 2022)
 - (1) If there are less than 16 players, points will be 5-4-3-2 Main and 2-1-1-0 Consolation. (March 2021)
 - Red Line State Doubles 8-6-5-3 Main; and 2-1-1-0 Consolation (2-1-1-1 if there are 16 or more teams in the division). (March 2022)

Regardless of the foregoing provisions, no points shall be awarded to any player who fails to win at least one match during the tournament. (March 2018)

CHANGE:

Add as a new paragraph to the above: "Amateurs who place in Open statewide tournaments will bank any points they would have earned. Banked points will be added to their Lifetime Pro Points upon elevation to Pro status."

REASON:

Amateurs who have placed in statewide Open tournaments have earned those lifetime points and should be allowed to keep them. However, as they have their own Tournament of Champions, those points should be banked rather than apply to the Pro TOC.
